Charlie kicks the ball

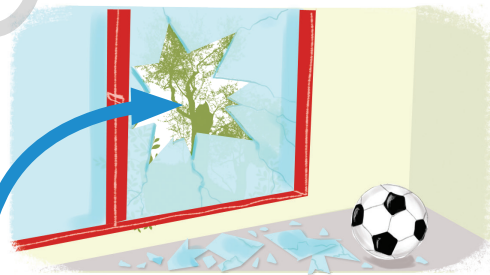


The ball is kicked by Charlie

These sentences tell us the same thing.



The ball broke the window



The window was broken by the ball

These sentences tell us the same thing.

In these sentences, we use the verb “be” and the third form.

Who cooks your dinner every day?

My ... *cooks* my dinner every day

Is his dinner cooked by his ... every day?

Yes, his dinner *is cooked* by his ... every day

Who cooked your dinner yesterday?

My ... *cooked* my dinner yesterday
